


Rib Rock Landscape Block

Oversize Rib Rock landscape units make a dramatic statement. Units are engineered to hold back a lot of earth. With their larger scale and natural aesthetics, oversize landscape block work in most applications.

Oversize block get the job done quickly and with minimal headaches. Place more square footage at a time and enhance the speed of your wall construction. Rib Rock's interlocking knob style block makes installation easy and secure. The knob placement and block dimensions allow for 90 degree corners. Half blocks help to maintain running-bond pattern. A top cap also gives a wall a clean, finished look.




Rib Rock-Corner





Mid-size Landscape Block


Mid-size Landscape Block

The smaller scale of the Mid-size Landscape Block is better proportioned for residential landscaping. Units are large enough to stand up to the most demanding jobs, yet small enough to be handled with light-duty equipment.


Mid-size block are right at home in residential settings where their rough hewn stone face adds architectural interest. With their tapered sides, Mid-size block can create curved walls with a radius as tight as six feet to the back of the block.




Mid-size-Full Block




Rib Rock Wall Set back= 2" per course

6 Foot Wall (Rib Rock)




****Site conditions may require Geogrid at 6'. Refer to site specific Engineering section below.**

8 Foot Wall (Rib Rock)




12 Foot Wall (Rib Rock)




Mid-size Wall Set back= 1" per course

Engineering

Oversize Rib Rock and Mid-size Landscape block can easily make walls up to 6 feet high. For walls over this height, geogrid and site specific engineering will be required. Terracing is another alternative to reach desired wall heights with little or no need for soil reinforcement. Engineering may still be required for local specifications and proper permitting.
